Community Overview

Homewood, IL, is a community of distinction, dedicated to preserving its rich heritage while keeping a keen eye toward the future.

Homewood's history dates back to the 1830s, as European settlers made their way here along the Vincennes Trail—an early Indian trail linking Vincennes, IN and Chicago. The area remained undeveloped until 1853, when James Hart platted the settlement of Hartford in what is now Homewood's downtown district. The same year, Hartford welcomed the Illinois Central Railroad. The new rail stop changed its name to Thornton Station for the prominent neighboring village of Thornton.

The railroad was a boon for the fledgling little town, spurring new business establishments, including the Thornton Flour Mill Company, general stores, blacksmiths and saloons. By 1869, the town, noted as “homes in the woods” by early settlers, changed its name one last time to Homewood. The community was officially incorporated in 1893.

Within a decade, Homewood had installed telephone and electric service and organized a Volunteer Fire Department and Police Department. The Illinois Central Railroad continued to be a significant part of community life, with as many as 10 round-trip trains making daily stops in Homewood during the early 1900s.

The city continued to grow in the 1920s, with a slight slow-down in expansion during the Great Depression. The town was home to approximately 3,000 in 1940—a number that surged with the explosive growth that followed the World War II era. By 1970, the population rose to nearly 18,000.

Today, Homewood is home to more than 19,500 residents and a diversified economy. This south suburb's high

quality of life has earned it much prestigious recognition over the years. Forbes named Homewood among the most livable metro-area suburbs in the Midwest, and the village has earned the Best of Chicago Southland's Best Community Award on numerous occasions. Chicago Magazine and the Chicago Tribune have also provided various recognitions for Homewood, including naming Homewood as one of the top 10 downtowns in the Chicagoland area.

While the village has developed immensely since its earliest days, it has retained its rustic, small-town character discovered in the quiet neighborhoods, preserved natural areas and charming downtown district. Come and experience the qualities of Home Sweet Homewood for yourself!



The Village of Homewood is ideally situated within Chicago's growing south suburbs. Part of Cook County, Homewood is positioned just 25 miles outside of the Loop and all of its culture, entertainment, shopping and dining. The community's strategic location places it in the midst of the Chicagoland area's extensive transportation network of highways, railways, public transportation and airports.

Commuters have quick access to the Bishop Ford Freeway (a portion of I-94), the Tri-State Tollway (I-80/I-94/I-294), I-57 and Lincoln Highway (U.S. Route 30), along with a web of local thoroughfares. Area residents also get around town by bicycle, thanks to the Village's dedication to developing a bicycle-friendly environment for transportation and recreational uses.

Several Pace bus routes provide local transit at a minimal fee in the Homewood area, and the Homewood Metra station offers convenient commuter rail service between University Park and Chicago (Metra Electric District line). Homewood hosts the first Amtrak station outside of Chicago, which is served by two daily routes: the Illinois Service, for those traveling down state, and the City of New Orleans route. Also making stops in Homewood is the Canadian National Railroad, which operates its U.S. headquarters here.

Access to regional, national and international air travel rounds out the transportation options for Homewood residents. Chicago's Midway International Airport is reachable within 35 minutes, while O'Hare International Airport is approximately 45 minutes from town.



Residential Living

Life is at its finest in the Village of Homewood, a prominent south suburban community. The Village has earned top nods for its high quality of life from such well-known resources as Forbes, Chicago Magazine and the Chicago Tribune. Distinguishing features of this tight-knit community include award-winning schools and recreation programs, a well-known downtown area, a dynamic economy and a great housing spread.

The neighborhoods of Homewood are characterized by a wonderful mix of housing options, from modest homes and preserved historic dwellings to luxurious estates. Residents do not have to move out of town in order to move up, as Homewood offers a wide selection of quality homes priced from as low as \$200,000 up through the multimillion-dollar range. The styles and sizes are just as diverse, adding to the value of living in this illustrious south suburban village.

Different family generations choose to stay in the Homewood area, with younger families laying roots in one of the many friendly, tree-lined neighborhoods and older residents taking advantage of local senior facilities. The 198-unit Freedom Village, a Carefree Development senior residential community in Homewood, is a fine choice for independent retirees. The village also hosts the South Suburban Rehabilitation Center, which offers an excellent Alzheimer and Memory Care Program in a compassionate, calm environment. Nearby, HCR ManorCare operates Arden Courts in Hazel Crest. The facility provides assisted living care to individuals suffering from Alzheimer's or other memory impairments.



Recreation

Homewood is a place that emanates community spirit, as residents remain active in various community happenings. All year long, the Village is flowing with events and activities the whole family can enjoy. Sample fine chocolates at the Chocolate Fest in February and take in the history of the railway at the two-day Railroad Heritage Days in May. Summertime is filled with fun events, including Drivin' the Dixie, the Art and Garden Street Fair, a 22-week Farmer's Market, Homewood Days, Fourth of July festivities, Movies in Our Parks and the Dog Days of Summer. September kicks off with the Fall Fest and annual Chili Cook-Off, while the year rounds out with the bright Holiday Lights in Homewood event and the New Years Eve Day Celebration.

The area's array of recreational opportunities also draws much participation from community members. The Homewood-Flossmoor Park District is a significant player in community life, offering a multitude of modern facilities and exciting programs and events. The park district is a two-time National Gold Medal Award Winner and a three-time Illinois Distinguished Agency, placing it among the top 10 percent of recreation agencies in the state.

In total, the H-F Park District manages 365 acres of land within 32 parks. Notable sites include Rover's Run Dog Park, eXtreme Scene Skate Park, Millennium Park Splash Pad, the Leavitt Sculpture Park and Patriots Park. The organization also operates several well-maintained facilities, including the H-F Ice Arena, H-F Racquet & Fitness Club, Iron Oaks Environmental Learning Center, Coyote Run Golf Course and the Irwin Community Center, to name a few. Rounding out the offerings of the park district are numerous special events and an assortment of programs, ranging from day camps, before- and after-school and preschool programs to aquatics, cultural arts and senior programs.

Golfers relish in the area's selection of courses, including two local, Donald Ross-designed golf courses. Novice

and experienced golfers alike enjoy the challenges of Ravisloe Country Club (public) and Calumet Country Club (private), both featuring well-maintained, 18-hole courses and a list of amenities. Nearby Flossmoor Country Club (private) and Olympia Fields Country Club (private) offer further opportunities to enjoy golf and other recreational activities.

Adding to the recreational scene of Homewood is the impressive Izaak Walton Preserve, a public 193-acre preserve nestled in the northeastern corner of the community. The area is highlighted by a mix of prairielands, woodlands, lakes, sand dunes and wetlands, attracting those interested in studying the local flora and fauna. Maintained footbridges curve around the preserve, which draws hikers, photographers and bird watchers. There are also sites for picnicking and Scout facilities, and if you choose to become a member, you may enjoy the preserve's fishing opportunities.

Homewood Baseball takes advantage of the serene environment, and utilizes three fields that are cut from the woods, offering children a "Field of Dreams"-like atmosphere. These fields host multiple regional baseball and softball tournaments, which draw families from all over the Southland and greater Chicagoland area.



Dining and Attractions

There is plenty to see and do in the Homewood area, and the dining selection is as impressive as it is varied. At the end of the day, visitors, whether in town on business or leisure, for a day or a week, are assured a pleasant place to rest at Homewood's local hotel or surrounding lodging facilities.

The Marie Irwin Community Center is a 27,000-square-foot facility that serves as the hub of community and park district programs and events. The always-bustling facility is situated in Downtown Homewood, within the six-acre Irwin Park. The modern center features an ongoing schedule filled with social events, such as Starry Nights (a summer outdoor concert series); cultural activities, leisure activities and more for all ages. The property also features a beautiful gazebo and an outdoor bandshell.

The award-winning Homewood Historical Society has strived to preserve local history for 30 years. The Society is located within the Dorband-Howe House Museum, a circa 1891 workingman's cottage. Made from "HOMEWOOD" stamped bricks, this historic treasure has been restored and is now a local history museum. Its library is lined with a growing collection of books and other printed material relating to Homewood's rich heritage. The Gift Shop is stocked with numerous items promoting Homewood's past, including books, postcards, photographs and more.

With a railroad bisecting Homewood in the center of town, it's no wonder the community has such a celebrated rail history. The Homewood Rail Watching Platform and Rail Park, located at the southern point of Illinois Central's Markham yard, serves as a tourist attraction for rail enthusiasts of all ages. The Rail Watching Platform, located at Harwood and Kroner Avenue, provides a terrific viewing point of the traffic from freight and commuter rail lines. The Rail Park, located on Park Avenue, just north of the train station, features a retired/restored locomotive and caboose. The underground pedestrian tunnel is adorned with murals depicting local

railroad history and connects the two attractions.

Homewood residents also have access to numerous nearby attractions, including the Governors State University's Center for Performing Arts and the encompassing Nathan Manilow Sculpture Park, along with the Flossmoor Sculpture Gardens and the opportunities of downtown Chicago.

Dining

Hungry patrons discover a great dining selection in Homewood, which is home to a mix of casual diners, fine dining establishments, coffeehouses, delis, taverns, fast-food eateries, ice cream parlors and pizzerias. Guests enjoy eclectic menus, featuring everything from delicious home-style cooking, hamburgers and handcrafted sandwiches to pizza, steak, seafood and pasta. Global fare is also available, with delectable Italian, Mexican, Chinese and Thai dishes gracing the restaurant list.



Shopping

Spend a day shopping in Homewood—a community that boasts a charming downtown district and a mix of modern retail areas.

Downtown Homewood has earned recognition among the top 10 best suburban downtowns in the Chicagoland area (Chicago Tribune). This quaint commercial district is lined with a fine collection of specialty shops and boutiques, dining establishments and service-oriented businesses, all housed within well-maintained Victorian-era structures. Downtown Homewood is a pedestrian-friendly destination that is always bustling with patrons on a search for the perfect gift or a delicious bite to eat. The district also hosts a Downtown Farmer's Market every Saturday from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. between June and mid-October.

The Halsted Street Corridor features nationally and regionally known retailers, while Cherry Creek Shopping Center along Governors Highway offers a mix of well-known stores and local establishments. Additional shopping areas include the Northgate (south of 175th Street) and Southgate (187th Street), shopping areas along Dixie Highway and the Westgate shopping area on 183rd Street and Western Avenue.



Education

First-rate education, from early childhood learning through graduate studies, is a cornerstone in the life of Homewood residents.

Homewood School District 153 is proud of its deep-rooted tradition of academic excellence, offering its student base of nearly 2,000 a fine, well-rounded public education in grades pre-kindergarten through eighth grade. Four facilities comprise School District 153, all of which boast standardized test scores that consistently rank above state and national levels.

The district feeds into the award-winning Homewood-Flossmoor High School District 233, which just celebrated its 50th anniversary in 2009. Twice named a National Blue Ribbon School of Excellence, H-F is a comprehensive high school dedicated to student academic success and personal growth. In addition to a rigorous curriculum, featuring traditional instruction and Advanced Placement courses, the school's diverse student body participates in more than 100 clubs and activities.

Homewood also hosts several daycare and early childhood learning centers, as well as unmatched opportunities for private and parochial school environments. Among the many local alternatives to public education are St. Joseph School, Salem Lutheran School, Homewood Christian Academy, Infant Jesus of Prague, Marian Catholic High School, Flossmoor Community Church, two Montessori schools and many others.

When it comes to continuing along the education path, Homewood students have access to two nearby institutions of higher learning. A few miles away, in Chicago Heights, is Prairie State College (PSC), a two-year community college granting associate degrees, as well as technical and career certificates, in more than 100 areas of study. PSC also offers non-credit adult basic education courses, corporate training programs and continuing

education.

Approximately 10 miles south of Homewood, students are provided with outstanding undergraduate or graduate degree completion opportunities at Governors State University (GSU) in University Park. GSU serves as the south suburbs' sole public university, enrolling around 7,750 students. Certificate programs are also available for those looking to hone their skills in a current career or are hoping to enter a new field.

Further options for higher learning in the area include South Suburban College in South Holland and Moraine Valley Community College in Palos Hills. Downtown Chicago also offers several options for graduating high school seniors and adults.

Homewood Public Library

Nestled within the center of Downtown Homewood, the modern Homewood Public Library is a staple in the community, offering a one-stop destination for education, culture and recreation. Part of the Metropolitan Library System, the Homewood Public Library features an extensive reference collection and exceptional kid, teen and adult collections, complete with modern technology and virtual library services. More than 110,000 books and 12,000 CDs and DVDs line the walls of the library, which is also equipped with public-use computer stations, WiFi connection, study rooms and quiet reading rooms. A calendar filled with special events and various programs, from book and film discussions to arts and crafts classes, rounds out the offerings of the Homewood Public Library.



A convenient location just outside of Chicago is coupled with a dynamic business environment and dedicated workforce in the Homewood area. The quality of life for local businesses and employees is exceptional, and the incentives to doing business here are unrivaled.

The area is filled with supportive, business-oriented organizations, including the Village of Homewood, exceptional higher learning institutions and the Homewood Area Chamber of Commerce. The Chamber is a diverse partnership of businesses and professionals who come together in order to “promote, strengthen and support all aspects of the business environment in the Villages of Homewood, Flossmoor, Glenwood and the surrounding communities.”

The organization provides an unmatched avenue for the business community to connect through a long list of programs and events. Membership in the Chamber is a valuable investment for active businesses and professionals interested in networking and ultimately getting their name out in the community. The Chamber invites members to join the Board of Directors or one of several committees, and take advantage of such benefits as member-to-member discounts, networking through monthly luncheons and Business After Hours events, as well as abundant opportunities for marketing. The Chamber offers a free membership listing in its community guide, an informational newsletter, sponsorship options and opportunities for advertising on the Chamber Web site.

Each year, in addition to regularly scheduled monthly events, the Homewood Area Chamber of Commerce sponsors several community-based events, including the large-scale Business to Business Expo, Homewood Days, the Annual Golf Outing and the Annual Fine Art Fair. These exciting events are well attended and much anticipated.

Healthcare

Maintaining a healthy lifestyle is important to Homewood residents, who fortunately live in proximity to several major hospital campuses and clinics. In town are numerous healthcare resources, providing care in a variety of fields—from chiropractic, dentistry and physical therapy to optometry, primary care and senior services.

St. James Hospital and Health Centers has served the south suburban area for nearly a century, expanding from a small, 50-bed hospital into a two-campus healthcare network. Both hospitals, located in Chicago Heights and Olympia Fields, are within five miles of Homewood, offering easy accessibility to award-winning services and programs. Notable features of St. James include the highly rated Heart and Vascular Institute, an accredited Diabetes Center, the Center for Bariatric Surgery, the Patricia A. Joyce Comprehensive Cancer Institute (an approved Teaching Hospital Cancer Program) and the St. James Health and Wellness Institute, a medically-based fitness center.

Ingalls Health System, the area's only independent not-for-profit healthcare system, operates its main campus, the 563-bed Ingalls Memorial Hospital, in nearby Harvey. The hospital is highlighted by several centers of excellence in the areas of cancer, heart, retina, surgery, orthopedics, rehabilitation, stroke care and gastroenterology. Additionally, U.S. News & World Report has named it one of "America's Best Hospitals" in the field of Neurosciences for seven years in a row.

Also part of the Ingalls network are several comprehensive outpatient centers, including Homewood's Ingalls Wellness Center. Here, patients access a number of programs and services, such as community education, health assessments, pulmonary rehabilitation, cardiac fitness, complementary medicine and weight management.

One of the nation's top 10 health systems (according to Thomson Reuters), Advocate Health Care, also has a

presence in the south suburbs. Neighboring Hazel Crest hosts Advocate South Suburban Hospital, a 289-bed acute-care medical center equipped with nearly 400 doctors. Advocate South Suburban houses a Level II designated Neonatal Intensive Care Nursery, a state-of-the-art Cancer Center, a modern Emergency Department and many other exceptional medical services. In addition, the hospital recently broke ground on a new, multimillion-dollar cardiac catheterization lab.



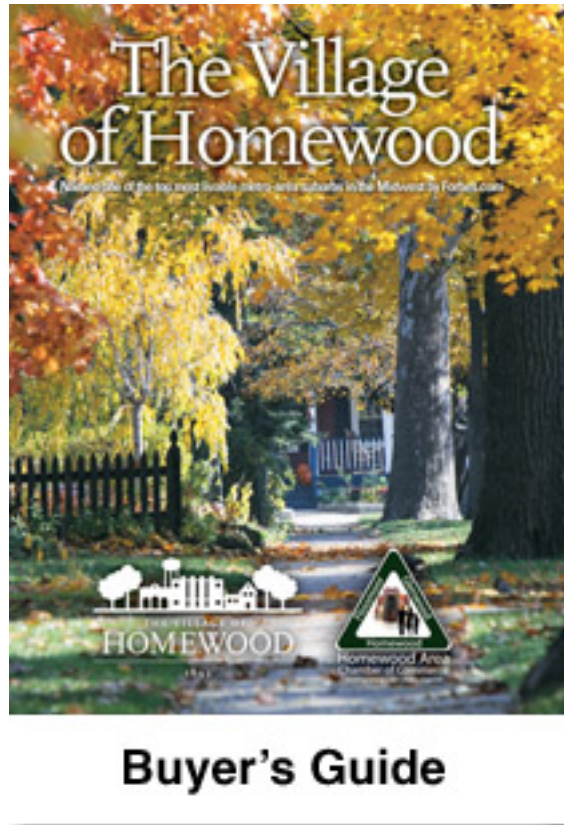
Government

The Village of Homewood remains progressive and committed to maintaining high-quality public services for its residents and businesses. Instituting a Council-Manager form of government, the people of Homewood are led by a six-member Board of Trustees, a Village President and a Village Clerk, all of which are elected to four-year terms. These leaders and policymakers employ a Village Manager to carry out policy and oversee the day-to-day tasks of the Village departments. The Board of Trustees meets the second and fourth Tuesday of the month. Residents are encouraged to attend and participate in Village Board meetings. Agendas and meeting minutes, as well as other Village services and information, are available on the Village Web site, www.homesweethomewood.com. Residents are encouraged to sign-up at the Village Web site to receive the e-News wire, the bi-weekly electronic newsletter, and tune in to the Village's cable station (Channel 4 for Comcast subscribers and Channel 99 for AT&T subscribers).



The spiritual community of Homewood remains strong and vibrant. Around a dozen houses of worship are situated within Homewood, with many others available in the surrounding area. Various religious denominations are represented, ensuring parishioners have access to their choice of faith. Most spiritual facilities in the area offer a range of programming and services, including traditional and special worship services, faith-based education and outreach programming.

The Homewood area is also home to several community organizations, designed to help those in need. Homewood hosts branches of the Lions Club, Rotary Club and the Charleston Transitional Facility (CTF), an Illinois-based organization serving individuals with developmental disabilities. The Jennifer S. Fallick Cancer Support Center is a local resource, offering current resources and free programs for those affected by cancer, while the South Suburban Family Shelter provides services to families and victims impacted by domestic violence. Nearby, the Good Shepherd Center assists those with developmental disabilities and the South Suburban Humane Society strives for quality animal welfare. Numerous other community organizations are available in the area and welcome people interested in volunteerism.

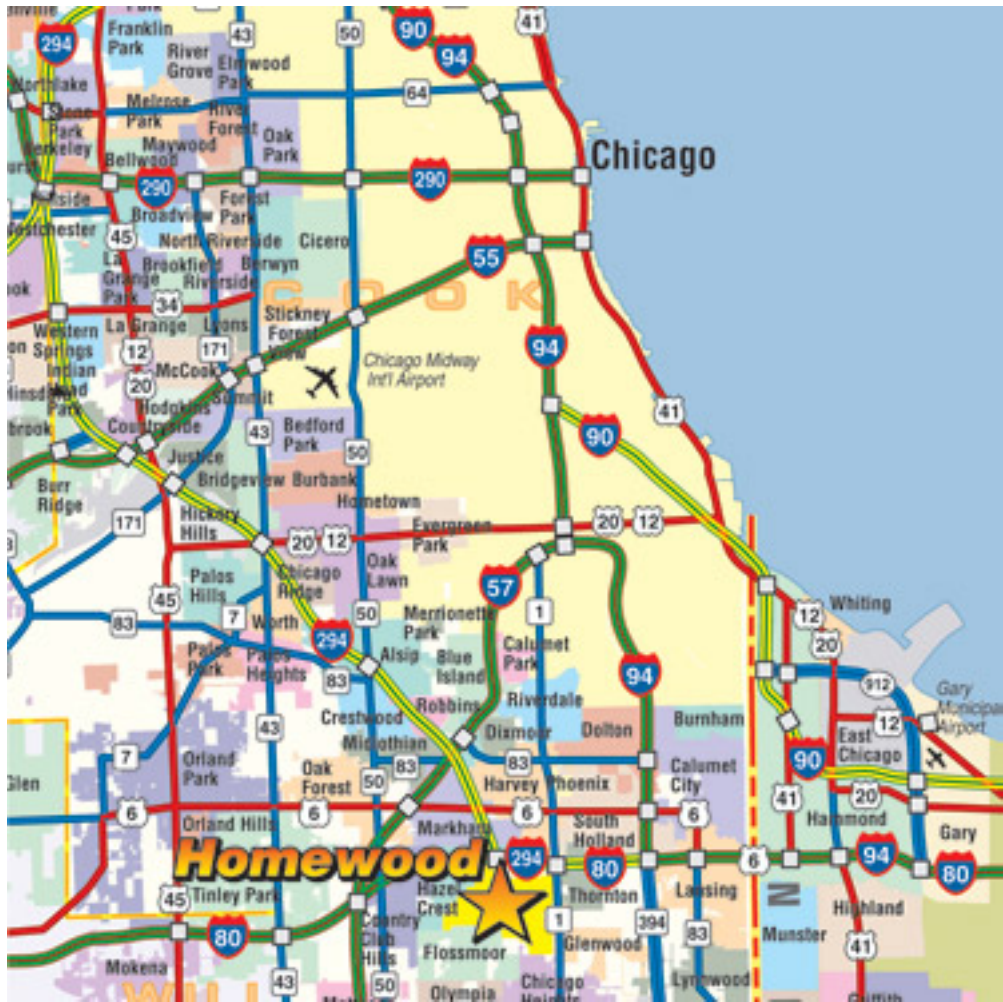
